

Terms and Conditions

By registering a student at Ballet Scotland you agree to the following

- I confirm that I have listed all medical conditions, including any learning difficulties, and that the student is generally in good health. I understand dance is a physical activity that may lead to tiredness and muscle aches. I understand that physical contact with the student will be necessary as part of the teaching process.
- I understand that Ballet Scotland accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury except where it can be shown to result directly from the negligence of the school.
- I give permission for the school to administer first-aid and authorise emergency medical treatment.
- I give consent for Ballet Academy Scotland to photograph or film the students I have enrolled. I understand that images taken may be used for publicity purposes.
- I understand that I am not permitted to take any images or recordings of students at Ballet Scotland, and that doing so may result in immediate removal from the school.
- I understand that the student will automatically be re-enrolled each term, and that it is my responsibility to inform the school if I wish to withdraw the student from classes.
- I agree to pay all fees due for tuition, and any additional fees agreed upon. I understand that fees are due in full prior to the first day of each term. I agree to give a minimum of 7 days notice prior to the start of each term if I wish to withdraw from classes.

Learning at home Lesson Requirements

1. There is a minimum of 2mSq of floor space and a minimum 2 metre clearance from floor to ceiling per participant in the room upon which they are undertaking the dance/exercise class.
2. There is no glass, china or other breakable material that may lead to injury in the room in which they are undertaking the dance/exercise class for the duration of the dance/exercise.
3. For any participants aged under 16, an appropriate adult (parent/carer aged 18+) must be present in the room at the same time.

4. If the participant is unable to follow the instructor's instructions they should cease the class immediately until it is possible to ask the instructor for further guidance.

5. There should be a maximum of two participants undertaking the dance/exercise class in the room at any one time (or two participants plus one supervising adult)

6. Activities are restricted to existing/known members of Ballet Academy Scotland
